TYPE OF FUND: Restricted Scholarship Fund

AMOUNT: \$100 for In-person attendance; \$50 for virtual attendance

AWARDED: These scholarships are awarded annually if fiscally feasible.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: January 23, 2022

PURPOSE: To provide a stipend to student members of the Pennsylvania Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics who attend the Annual Meeting and Exhibition (AME).

CRITERIA AND RESTRICTIONS FOR USE OF THE FUND:

- 1. The recipient must be a current member of the Pennsylvania Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics and meet one of the following criteria:
 - a. Is enrolled in an Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND)-accredited/approved DPD or CP.
 - b. Be accepted by an ACEND-accredited/approved DI or ISPP. Application for scholarship may be made in advance of acceptance; however, acceptance must be confirmed by the time recipient is chosen.
 - c. Be admitted to, or in present pursuit of, a program of graduate study in a dietetics-related program at a regionally accredited college or university with the intent to practice in the field of dietetics
- 2. Must register and pay to attend the AME. Student volunteers for the annual meeting are not eligible for student stipends.

OTHER CONDITIONS/INFORMATION:

Selection criteria will be based on:

- 1. Financial need (50%)
- 2. Commitment to continued professional development in the dietetics profession as evident from applicant's statement (30%)
- 3. Leadership ability as evident in applicant's statement and resume (20%)

When applicable, students awarded a scholarship will be required to write a letter or establish e-mail communication with the Pennsylvania Academy of Nutrition and

Dietetics member or donor who provided the scholarship monies. Students will be provided contact information about the donor. A letter of thanks and a brief statement about the student's meeting experience will be expected to be mailed within three (3) weeks of the meetings completion.
